Background to the role - some facts about the parishes and school

Dagenham is a town in Essex, served by the District line and is close to the M25. In recent times there has been a significant change in the population of the area and therefore the school. All Saints school has 240 pupils in each year, from year 7 to year 11 as well as a Sixth Form. There are three Catholic primary schools in Dagenham, but many of our students travel into Dagenham from the neighbouring London Boroughs of Havering, Redbridge and Newham.

Mass attendance in the parishes is approximately 750 people, with a congregation of mixed age range. There are some wonderful and very supportive families, and some excellent young people throughout the 11-18 range.

Our School

We are a high achieving 11 -18 school with very good examination results. We have received an Educational Outcomes award for being in the top 20 percent of schools in the country for progress. The School is a Teaching School and excellent professional development opportunities are available for colleagues in a forward thinking and creative organisation.
