Welcome back to a new academic year. I trust you and your families had a great summer. The last six weeks has gone by incredibly fast. I would like to welcome to our community the parents and students of Yr. 7 & 12.

Pupils have returned with excellent uniform and incredibly focused attitude to learning. It is wonderful to see them again after the summer break.

As in recent years I have been able to write and update you on our summer exam successes. I am delighted to report further success of our students and the All Saints community.

There has been much to celebrate.

'A' Level – We received an overall ALPs Score of 3 for our sixth form which indicates we are a very good sixth form.

- 96% of Yr. 13 have gone to University with the other 4% going onto apprenticeships/employment.
- Nearly 50% of our 'A' Level results were A*-B
- A 20% increase in pupils securing Russell Group university places.

GCSE

- 25% of all GCSE grades were in the 9-7 range (A*/A) Grade 9 is the Governments Gold Standard and represents just 2% of students in the Country. All Saints achieved 60 of these.
- GCSE results were significantly above national results in all areas.
- For the 3rd year running our measure of pupil progress (Progress 8 measure) has increased. We now evidenced that pupils attending All Saints achieve on average at least half a grade higher than expected based on their incoming data

- Gold Healthy Schools Status
- Excellence in Inclusion Award
- CPD Quality Mark



Over the summer holidays we were informed that we have been awarded full International School Status in recognition of our work celebrating the international links and cultural diversity of our school.

As you can see much has been achieved and our results are an excellent start to our academic year 2018/19. We are never complacent and recognise that the results are a result of our continuing excellent parental support.


